So, how do you actually search for materials using a finding aid?

For University Archives and the Manuscripts Collection, we use **ArchivesSpace**, which is an archives collections and finding aid database. For extra support using ArchivesSpace, visit our **user guide**.

You can get to ArchivesSpace directly with the link above, or on the **SC&UA homepage** you can use the search box to search for finding aids. Be sure to use the "ArchivesSpace" tab when you search. You can also use the links on the homepage under "Our Archival Finding Aids" to access finding aids for the relevant collection.

Similar to searching the library catalog, you may search for terms such as people, places, events, and topical keywords.
